When the "Evacuate" tones sound via the evacuation PA system team members, contractors and visitors must evacuate the Distribution Centre immediately.		
Team members, visitors and contractors are required to report all accidents / incidents / injuries.		
It is expected that any work activities that are carried out on site will not affect the integrity of the food products.		
Children are permitted on the DC floor and in the yard.
